Issues in Criminalization and Imprisonment (Eligible for 5 CPD Credits)

This prison law course is designed to orient lawyers and advocates to key issues related to incarceration and the correctional system. As part of this course, you will analyze legislation, case law and reports, as well as supplementary research materials. The goal of the course is to think critically about the ethical and other constraints upon counsel in trying to assist prisoners, the specific barriers confronted by women prisoners (particularly Indigenous women and women with mental health issues), as well as legal and other reforms that are possible in this area.



Bail Verification and Supervision Program

The Bail Verification and Supervision Program (BVSP) includes the verification of information about accused persons at bail hearings and the supervision of accused persons as an alternative to custody while awaiting a court disposition and/or trial. The Bail Program supervises individuals who would otherwise qualify for bail, but have limited finances and social ties in the community. It provides important support to vulnerable people and helps them to carry on with their lives in the community while awaiting trial.

This program is funded by the Ministry of the Attorney General and was implemented by the Elizabeth Fry Society of Peterborough beginning June 2017 in Peterborough and July 2017 for the Lindsay area.
